RADO – ANNUAL REPORT

Sporting Schools – Being able to deliver Volleyball Sporting Schools programs in the local area has been very beneficial to the sport of Volleyball, schools in the area, the partnership between Volleyball Victoria / WRSA and of course the participants.

Volleyball Horsham has been able to financially benefit from the delivery of Sporting Schools programs by being able to charge for the delivery of the programs.

Schools have been able to receive experienced and accredited coached sessions from a local person to their students. Schools have also been able to buy equipment from the funding, to assist in their own deliver of Volleyball in their schools.

Four Sporting Schools programs were delivered in the local area to a total of over two hundred students.

Karen Community Volleyball Program –In the second half of 2019 I was able to assist Matt Jolly deliver a stretch funding project with the Karen community in Nhill.

The program ran throughout August and September with volleyball sessions being offered.

The program was well received by the Karen community, and although there were some language barriers, there was a lot of internationally recognized smiles and laughter shared.

Participants were from all ages and was very rewarding personally.

As second round of sessions was delivered which included Caneball alongside Volleyball in November and December, and the same great enthusiasm and enjoyment from the participants was evident.
