

TEXT RESULTS TO MATT 0403 984 165 AFTER EACH GAME



PLAYING CONDITIONS

1. All round matches will be played no time limit compulsory three sets to 21.
 - A "golden point" will be played once the score reaches 20-20.
 - If the score is one set each a deciding set will be played to 15 with a 2 point advantage, no change of ends to be taken.
 - No time outs – a 30 second game time out will automatically be taken when the score reaches 20-20.
 - 12 subs
 - liberos can change per set
 - 2 minutes between sets
 - No change of ends.
 - Times are guaranteed earliest start times.
 - There will be a 10-minute changeover between matches.
 - Games are not to commence until the scoresheet is completed ie: player names, numbers, delete players not playing, add players not listed.
2. Premiership points will be allocated as follows: -
 - 5 points for a win 3-0.
 - 4 points for a win 2-1.
 - 1 point for a loss 1-2.
 - 0 points for a loss 0-3.
 - -1 point for a forfeit.
 - Ladder positions will be decided firstly on premiership ranking points, if equal, set percentage, if still equal points percentage, if still equal head-to-head.
 - An up-to-date result service will be available via QR code which will be on the draw and posted up around each venue.
 - Grand finals will be played off between the top two teams on the ladder. All finals will be played under the same conditions but best of five sets to 21 with a "golden point" played at 20-20, no time limit. If a deciding set is required it will be played to 15 with a 2 point advantage.
3. The 2026 interpretation of a double hit rule will not be played in this tournament. Therefore a double hit interpreted by the referee still stands until next year.
4. Teams rostered for duty are to supply referee, net referee, scorer and 2 linesmen. The provision of a scoreboard operator is encouraged but optional. Penalties for lack of duty members at the start of or during a match will be the loss of 1 premiership point per duty member absent. Referees are required to award MVP votes at the end of each match. Failure to do so will mean the loss of 1 premiership point. Teams penalized under these conditions will be notified after the match has been completed. Duty teams are asked to collect the scoresheets and match balls from the tournament office each time and return them once the match is complete.
5. Teams must present at least 6 players to play at the start of the tournament. If through injury during a tournament match only this number is reduced to 5 the team will be permitted to play without penalty. Teams playing with 5 players must play with a blank in the empty position maintaining other rotational positions. Should a team be reduced to less than 5 players, the match or remainder thereof will be forfeited, but any points gained during the unfinished match will be retained for the purpose of calculating percentage.
6. If a team fails to show at the GEST they forfeit the first set. If after 10 minutes they still haven't shown, they forfeit the match 3-0 63-0.
7. All players must take the court in FOUR ROUND ROBIN MATCHES to be able to qualify for finals. If a club is represented in multiple divisions at this tournament there is to be no movement of players between divisions, unless injury occurs and permission is sought from the tournament manager first.
8. All members of the team must be uniformly attired, including shirts, shorts and socks. Penalty for out of uniform will be 5 points to the opposition per member out of uniform per set. **Please note taped numbers will not be accepted.**
9. A libero player is per set and must be indicated on the rotation slip at the beginning of each set. All teams are to be familiar with 12 sub scoresheets as they will be used.
10. All players will play at their own risk and the Volleyball Horsham will not be held responsible for any medical or associated costs incurred.
11. Any disputes or protests that arise during a match shall be referred to the chief referee David Berry for immediate resolution. (0487824599)
12. In any division, coaches are reminded of their code of conduct when dealing with officials, especially junior officials. Any coach breaking the code of conduct will be referred to the chief referee upon completion of the match.
13. The Stadium has a heat policy, which will be implemented, and teams advised, when the temperature rises above 35 degrees C.
14. Blood Rule – anyone who is bleeding, or has blood on their clothing, must be immediately substituted and the blood removed – cuts, etc shall be completely covered, clothing cleaned or changed. Blood on the floor, the ball, or any other equipment, must be cleaned up using the blood kit available before play resumes.
15. The interpretation and decision of the Volleyball Horsham committee will be final on all matters covered and not covered in these conditions.
